**Get Out the Vote (GOTV):**

- Help with voter registration drives to ensure as many eligible voters as possible are registered.
- Volunteer for GOTV efforts on Election Day to assist with voter turnout and transportation to polling places.

**Display Campaign Materials:** Show your support by placing campaign signs or bumper stickers on your property or vehicle, if allowed by local ordinances and campaign rules.

**Host or Attend Fundraising Events:** Participate in or host fundraising events for the candidate. Invite friends and neighbors to join you in supporting your candidate financially.

**Recruit Supporters:** Encourage friends, family members, and neighbors who share your political views to get involved and support the candidate.

**Register to Vote:** Make sure you talk to friends and family to ensure they're registered to vote. Your vote is one of the most valuable ways to support your candidate.
